Pray for Evangelistic Missions, Trauma Healing & Reconciliation, Elections and Leaders

- 01** Pray for Benson Omondi and the AE Kenya Team in their preparations with local church leaders for an evangelistic mission to Kisumu in western Kenya, a city of 1.1 million on Lake Victoria. The mission will be June 1 to 8 this year.
- 02** Pray for the government, political and business leaders in Kigali, Rwanda, as AE gears up for an evangelistic mission targeted at the country's top echelons of influence in the capital city from June 24 to 30.
- 03** Pray for Rob Clements, AE South Africa Board Chair, and for the AE South Africa Board as they meet to discern the way forward amidst the challenges in their country during these trying times.
- 04** "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him." – James 1:5
- 05** Pray for the AE Tanzania Team as they just recently lost Team Leader Emmanuel Mbaaga to cancer, that the Board would find a good new Team Leader and that the Team can still spearhead an effective evangelistic mission to the capital city of Dodoma from July 14 to 21.
- 06** Pray for AE South Africa in their work of uniting Christian leaders around a common evangelistic vision to reach Johannesburg from September 5 to 15.
- 07** Pray for Team Leader Brian Mugwidi as he leads a citywide evangelistic mission to Harare, Zimbabwe's capital, between September 20 and 29 this year.
- 08** Pray for unity among the church leaders of Soroti in Uganda and that AE's Team Leader Benson Baguma and his Team in their preparations for the mission from September 21 to 29.
- 09** Cornelius Huwa, AE's Malawi Team Leader, and his colleagues are working on an evangelistic mission to Mzuzu from October 6 to 13 this year. Pray for open hearts to the Gospel in this city of more than 220,000.
- 10** Pray for wisdom, protection and encouragement for Janet Mwendwa, AE's Social Action Director, in her work of overseeing and monitoring of AE's community development projects that help lift thousands out of poverty each year.
- 11** "He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord, and He will pay back what he has given." – Proverbs 19:17
- 12** Pray for the trauma healing projects AE operates in the public schools of Juba, South Sudan, where decades of civil war has left deep scars especially in children.
- 13** Pray for Alima, a 20-year-old young woman in Juba who witnessed her mother and sister be killed and who harbored hatred in her heart for the killers but has come to a place of forgiveness. Pray for her to complete her secondary schooling which was delayed by the war.
- 14** Pray for more schools around Juba to be open to hosting trauma healing ministry and for the funding to carry it out.
- 15** Pray that students who experience healing from trauma and new life in Christ will be able to minister this healing work to others.
- 16** Pray for peace to come to all corners of South Sudan and for the angry and aggrieved to lay down their weapons and seek understanding and reconciliation with those whom they have been fighting against.
- 17** Pray for Ben Sachie, AE's Ghana Team Leader, as he shares the Gospel in his home city of Accra, the capital, and prepares an evangelistic mission to the city of Tema in October.
- 18** "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds." Psalm 147:3.
- 19** This year of 2024 is a momentous election year for many countries across Africa. Please pray that elections will be free and fair and that wise, moral, large-hearted and even Christian leaders would be elected.
- 20** Pray for the citizens of Malawi that they would elect quality leaders in their national assembly and local elections in May this year. Malawi is blessed with a strong Christian as president in Lazarus Chakwera.
- 21** Pray for the presidential elections in Rwanda in July for president and the chamber of deputies. Current president Paul Kagame has been in power for 24 years.
- 22** Pray for presidential and legislative elections in South Africa in May. South Africa has been beset by racial and political strife as well as rolling electrical blackouts which have constrained needed economic growth. Wise and courageous leadership is vital.
- 23** Pray for the presidential and national assembly elections in Ghana in December. Ghana has been blessed with stable governance for much of its history but still needs new and wise leaders for the future.
- 24** Pray for AE's Communications Manager, Esther Chengo, who helps convey stories and reporting from AE's ministry out of her home base in Nairobi, Kenya.
- 25** "I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence." – 1 Timothy 2:1-2
- 26** Pray for AE's Pastor Training Course, run in partnership with Moore Theological College in Australia, which educates and prepares pastors who are passionate about the Gospel but have no Bible or theology training.
- 27** Pray for AE Rwanda's School Chaplain and Discipleship program which develops and prepares young people for Christian leadership in schools around the country.
- 28** Pray for AE's involvement in the Lausanne Movement for Global Evangelization, a worldwide network begun in 1974 by Billy Graham. International Team Leader Stephen Mbogo serves as Lausanne Africa Regional Director and International Missions Director Emmanuel Kwizera is Proclamation Evangelism Catalyst. Many AE leaders will be meeting in Seoul, South Korea, this September for the 50th anniversary of Lausanne to coordinate with other Christian leaders about evangelizing Africa and the entire world.
- 29** Pray for the Student Discipleship program in Ethiopia as it disciples tens of thousands of young people around the country.
